The educational qualification notified for the post is as under :- (i) Master Degree of a recognized university in Hindi with English as a main subject at Degree level OR (ii) Master Degree of a recognized university in English with Hindi as a main subject at Degree level OR (iii) Master Degree of a recognized university in any subject with Hindi and English as a main subject at Degree level OR (iv) Bachelors Degree of a recognized university with English and Hindi as a main subjects at Degree level.

The candidates must bring certificates fulfilling the educational qualification notified for the post for eligible to appear for the translation test. The candidates who are having desired educational qualification only will be allowed to appear for the translation test.

The candidates are required to bring all their original mark sheets including each years of degree and Post Graduation degree mark sheets (if any) and certificates including the original disability certificate issued by the Competent Authority. The candidates must produce their original matriculation certificate for verification of date of birth, Master Degree/ Degree certificate of a recognised university on the day of translation test without fail. If any of the above candidates does not receive the call letter, the candidate may check the Railway Recruitment Board's notice board/website and attend the translation test strictly on the specified date indicated along with all documents.

The candidates belonging to SC/ST & OBC should bring their original caste certificate in prescribed format. In case of OBC candidates the caste certificate should be current and not more than one year old and should have clause of Non-Creamy Layer.

Candidates should bring their original call letters of Written Examination and translation test. The Candidates should also bring photocopies of all the original certificates and documents including the original disability certificate issued by the Competent Authority for translation test. Any candidate coming for the translation test without complete documents will be asked to return and their candidature shall be liable to be cancelled.

Merely calling the candidates for translation test will not confer on them the right for employment in any Zonal Railway/Railway Organisation.

While every care has been taken in preparing the result, the Railway Recruitment Board reserves the right to rectify errors and omissions if any.

IMPORTANT : Beware of touts who may misguide the candidates with false promises of getting them selected for the job on illegal consideration. The recruitment process in the RRB exams is fully computerized and selection is based purely on the merit of candidates.
